By the time our Center students graduate, they have:

- Received a min. of 10 hours with a college admissions advisor per [US News and World Report](#), a min value of \$2000
- Scored an average of 1390 on the SAT -- 275 points higher than the [2022](#) California state average
- Created college-level research of their own design that they can use to compete for scholarships and earn awards at national level competitions
- Received over \$3 million in merit scholarships
- Earned admission to top tier colleges. Seventy-five percent of admitted students in the last five years were Center students.
